Qualifications

- Graduating senior (Class of 2026)
- Enrolled in the Natomas Unified School District
- Student-athlete participating in a school-sanctioned athletic program

Application Requirements

- Completed online scholarship application
- One written essay (minimum 500 words)
- One letter of reference (teacher, coach, counselor, or community mentor)
- Athletic participation verification completed by a coach or athletic director (*form available on website*)
- Available for a brief Zoom conversation *if requested*

Application Timeline

- Applications Open: March 1, 2026
- Applications Close: March 31, 2026
- Application Review: April 2026
- Finalists Announced: May 2, 2026 (at the Monty Maxwell Legacy Walk)
